REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Citizenship requirements to participate in the 2017 BC Junior Provincial Championship are:

1. Permanent Residency (PR) card must be dated 365 days from the start of the BC Junior Provincial Championship in the previous year.
2. In the period between the issuing of the PR card and the BC Junior Provincial Championship the athlete must participate in two (2) of the Junior A circuit events
3. In the period between the issuing of the PR card and the BC Junior Provincial Championship the athlete must participate in one Junior Elite Series event
4. In the period between the issuing of the PR card and the BC Junior Provincial Championship the athlete must participate in one (1) Provincial Championship

The Championship is open only to those athletes who have met eligibility criteria for participation in the provincial championships. To view the eligibility policy and list of currently eligible athletes visit badmintonbc.com. Deadline for eligibility appeals is March 28, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. PDT submitted by email to executivedirector@badmintonbc.com.

All athletes must be current (2016-2017) members in good standing and have a minimum Badminton BC Competitive Provincial membership.

All coaches must be current (2016-2017) member in good standing and have a minimum Badminton BC Associate Membership and have registered as an Accredited Coach.

All participants must agree to the Code of Conduct at time of registration.

Draws and start times will be posted by April 19, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. via Tournament Software. There will be no late entries or refunds after the withdrawal date of April 12, 2017.

TOURNAMENT RULES

The 21-Rally Point scoring format will be utilized. The rules of Badminton BC and Badminton Canada are in effect – 10 minute default rule applies and 3-minute warm up period.

UNIFORMS

All athletes and coaches participating in any sanctioned Badminton BC Provincial Championship will be restricted to having their NAME and/or CLUB/PROVINCE on their competitive clothing. The athlete clothing is not required to have any indicators on their competitive uniforms.

COACH ACCREDITATION AND ELIGIBILITY

All coaches wishing to coach on court and access the field of play must be Badminton BC accredited. Registration and current membership are required. All coaches must be:

- 1) An Association member in good standing with Badminton BC for 2016-2017
- 2) Meet mandatory NCCP certification requirements of NCCP Level 1 CERT or NCCP Regional Coach CERT
- 3) Wear coach accreditation badges during all matches and sit in the identified chairs.
